What is the NorthBay Science Live Program?

NorthBay makes science come alive by involving students in authentic hands on estuarine research aboard their research vessel, the **Miss Nancy**. Students will actively participate in bottom ecology research, fisheries biology research and estuary restoration activities. Students will learn scientific skills and processes by directly participating in them!



Trips on Monday and Friday

What does the program look like?



Educational activities are hands-on and all participants, including teachers get involved with the data collection process. Students will use a bottom dredge to sample the life living on the bottom of the Upper Chesapeake. They will **actively participate** in collecting and analyzing data on the catch, depending on the research question and mission of the cruise.



Time: Trips are on Monday and Friday and are five hours long. Trips typically start at 9 am and end at 2 pm, but start and stop times are negotiable to meet school schedules.

Instructors: All instructors are experienced marine biologists and educators.

Curriculum Based: Aligned with Maryland VSC

Grades: Trips are developed for grades 4-12
